



# SAR LOOP PROSERVES

#### STUDENT DROP OFF

-STUDENTS CAN BE DROPPED OFF IN THE CAR LOOP IN THE MORNING 20 MINUTES BEFORE SCHOOL BEGINS (7:50 AM)

-MAKE SURE TO MAKE TWO LINES AND PULL ALL THE WAY UP TO THE FRONT OF THE LINE BEFORE YOUR CHILD LEAVES THE VEHICLE

-WAIT FOR THE WHISTLE TO HAVE YOUR CHILD EXIT THE VEHICLE OR MOVE FORWARD, WE ARE YOUR EYES!

#### STUDENT PICK UP

-TWO LINES RUNNING AT THE SAME TIME IN THE AFTERNOON

-COMMUNICATE WITH YOUR CHILD
THE CAR YOU'LL BE PICKING THEM
UP IN, THEY WILL BE DISMISSED TO
WAIT UNDER THE AWNING (UNLESS
THERE IS INCLEMENT WEATHER)

-STUDENTS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO CROSS THE PARKING LOT FOR SAFETY REASONS.

## STUDENT BUS LOOP PROCEDURES

- STUDENTS WILL BE DISMISSED IN 3 WAVES THE LAST 2 WILL BE FOR BUSES.
  - WAVE 2: BUSSES THAT HAVE ARRIVED (LISTED AND ANNOUNCED)
  - WAVE 3: LATE BUSSES TO THE CAFETERIA
- WHEN STUDENTS ARRIVE AT THE BUS LOOP, THEY CAN LOOK FOR THEIR BUS OR ASK AN ADULT WITH A BUS ROSTER FOR THE LOCATION OF THEIR BUS. BUSES ARE SET UP IN TWO LINES, SO STUDENTS NEED TO LOOK CAREFULLY IF THEY DO NOT ASK AN ADULT
- STUDENTS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO USE THE CROSSWALK AT THE BUS LOOP BECAUSE IT IS A SAFETY CONCERN FOR STUDENTS TO WALK IN FRONT OF THE SCHOOL BUSES
- STUDENTS HAVE ROUGHLY 10 MINUTES (AFTER THE FIRST WEEK OF SCHOOL) TO BE ON THEIR BUS BEFORE THE BUSES ARE DISMISSED TO ROLL OUT.
  - IF STUDENTS MISS THEIR BUS, A PARENT WILL BE REQUIRED TO COME AND PICK THEM UP.

#### Dress Code Policy

These guidelines are in effect while on any District School Board of Pasco County school or campus, at any school function or on any school-sponsored transportation.

- · Students must wear clothing that has fabric on the front, back, and sides.
- · Shirts must have straps and extend to the waist.
- Fabric covering chests, genitals and buttocks must be opaque.

- Any clothing that depicts gang-related images, indicates gang affiliation, or antisocial group affiliation.
- Wallet chains, spiked jewelry, dog collars or similar items.
- · Pajamas or costumes (unless approved by school administration for special events, etc.)
- Hats, bandanas or head coverings (unless preapproved administratively for medical, religious reasons and/or for special school activities)

OR AS EXPRESSLY AUTHORIZED BY
THE CLASSROOM TEACHER FOR A
SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONAL ACTIVITY

USING A WCD TO CAPTURE,
RECORD AND/OR TRANSMIT AUDIO
AND/OR PICTURES/VIDEO OF AN
INDIVIDUAL WITHOUT PROPER
CONSENT IS CONSIDERED AN
INVASION OF PRIVACY AND IS NOT
PERMITTED. STUDENTS WHO
VIOLATE THIS PROVISION AND/OR
USE A WCD TO VIOLATE THE
PRIVACY RIGHTS OF ANOTHER
PERSON MAY HAVE THEIR WCD
CONFISCATED AND HELD UNTIL THE
END OF THE SCHOOL DAY OR UNTIL
A PARENT/GUARDIAN PICKS IT UP.
